COVID 19 - ACTION PLAN
REVISED APRIL 1, 2021

Cactus Jack's Saloon & Grill not only works in the community we live in the community. We are eager to fight COVID 19 on the frontlines. We are always looking for ways to improve our efforts to keep you safe. Please reach out if you have any ideas, cares or concerns. We do NOT allow any of our employees to come to work SICK. It doesn't matter if it is COVID 19 or a common cold. We realize the importance to allow our employees to take the time off they need to recover. In particular for COVID 19, we do pay our staff to stay home. It shouldn't be a choice for our employees.

Masks are mandatory and enforced. While patrons are inside they must be seated at a table. While seated they can remove their masks while waiting on food, enjoying their drinks. Once the patron gets up from the table, they are expected to place their mask back on. For those individuals playing pool, please keep your masks on at all times.

Tables are 6-10' apart depending on the color level of the county. We are currently at Level Blue in Jefferson County. This means that indoor dining is allowed at 100% capacity with 6 foot distancing between non-household members. 10 people are allowed for outdoor dining per table. Last call is 2 am.

Our outdoor dining consists of green houses and ice fishing tents. These are specifically designed for single household parties. Each green house is stocked with an electric heater. At the top of each green house is an opening for ventilation. We provide blankets and heating pads for our customers upon request. We are entering our warmer months and have a HUGE outside patio for your pleasure.

Regular Sanitation & Cleaning of High Touch Surfaces

We have designed a "Sanitation Station" for staff and patrons to use. We stock it with hand sanitizer, gloves, masks and other items for your safety. We wipe down all tables in between customers with cleaner specifically designed to protect from Coronavirus 19. If we are seating you in the green houses or ice fishing tents, we give each one 5 minutes in between to air out. We sanitize highly trafficked areas every hour. If you would politely address your server if you think an area is in need of attention. Of course, we try to do our best, but mistakes happen.

Daily Employee Symptom & Exposure Checks:

1. Daily Temperature Checks. If an employee's temperature is above normal they do not clock in and are sent home immediately.

If an employee has been exposed, they are required to quarantine until they can produce a negative test or quarantined for 14 days. If an employee test positive, they are required to stay

home during their illness and quarantined. Due to the variance of incubation periods, we are requiring a 14 day quarantine for anyone who has tested positive and employed by us.

2. Contact Tracing: Cactus Jack’s uses “All Checked In” App to trace everyone who comes through the doors. It is easy and safe to use. When you enter Cactus Jack’s, before you are seated you provide the hostess with your contact number in the case of exposure. Just one of the people in the group need to provide information. The app company is contacted by Colorado Department of Health and Environment if a person tests positive that was known to be in Cactus Jack’s the same time your party was. The app company, All Checked In will contact you directly. None of tracing goes through Cactus Jack’s Saloon & Grill. This is a requirement for 5 Star Certification.

“What is required for a customer symptom and exposure check?”

The best practice for a symptom and screening check is to use the CDPHE screening form to ask if a patron has any symptoms, or was recently exposed to somebody known to have COVID-19. It is recommended that a temperature is taken as part of this process, but it is acceptable to verbally ask if the person has a temperature if necessary. Temperature checks are required for employee symptom and exposure checks.”

In addition to everything required by the Jefferson County Health Department, we have installed two Hepa Filters that collect any water droplets in the air.
